

6 1/2" unfinished block

## 6 1/2" Nine Patch Block:

Fabric A: cut (4) $21 / 2$ " squares Fabric B: cut (4) $21 / 2$ " squares Fabric C: cut (1) $21 / 2$ " squares

## 12 1/2" Nine Patch Block:

Fabric A: cut (4) $41 / 2$ " squares Fabric B: cut (4) $41 / 2$ " squares Fabric C: cut (1) $41 / 2$ " squares


Using a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance, sew the rows to each other. Press seams toward the middle row.

## Block Assembly:

Using a l/4" seam allowance, sew the rows together. Press seams toward the (B) blocks in each row.

Did you know?
The nine patch quilt block has been around since the beginning of the 19th century. This beginner friendly block made of 9 equal sized squares has endless variations.
